Amid the rising concerns, fears, and uncertainties related to the Covid-19 virus have prompted Open Hands UCM to continue our proactive stance on the safety and security of volunteers and guests.

Imagine adding food insecurity to the anxiety many are feeling now. Many families in our community depend on Open Hands and they need us now more than ever. Our food distribution will continue to follow the regular Tuesday and Thursday schedule. However, we will modify our approach starting March 17 to a drive through method in order to minimize or eliminate contact between volunteers and guests. Guests will be asked to stay in their vehicle and no guest will be allowed into the building. We ask for your patience as the process evolves, as it may need to be tweaked a bit during implementation.

We will not have a financial assistance day this Wednesday, March 18, but plans are being made to make assistance possible. We hope to have a plan in place by April 1.
